People get tired, take leave, quit, or get overloaded.

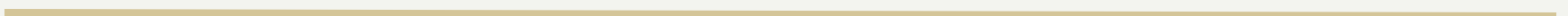
Systems don't.

Systems provide continuity.

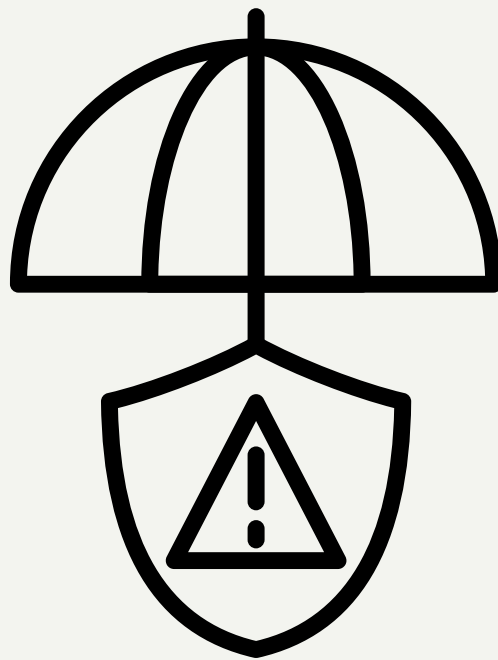
3. Systems enable scale
